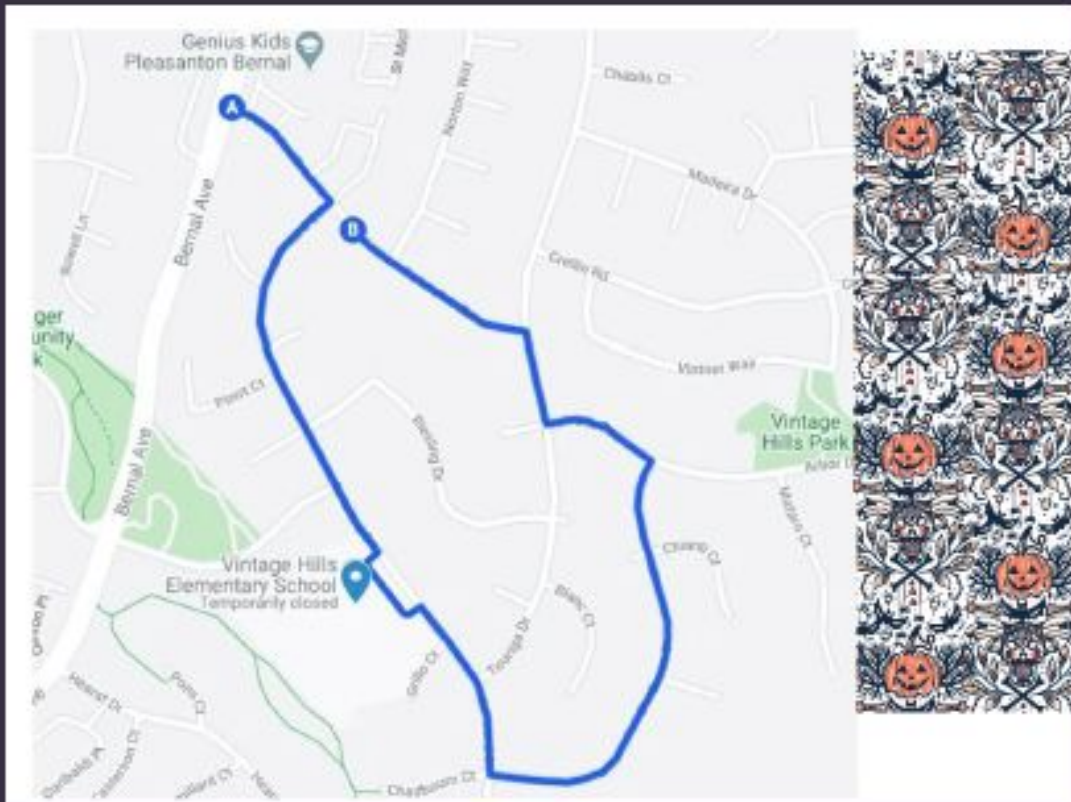

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Map & Directions

- Drive up **CONCORD** Street toward Vintage Hills Elementary.
- Turn **RIGHT** into the school parking lot and travel through.
- Take a **RIGHT** onto **CONCORD** and drive to **BORDEAUX**
- Take a **LEFT** onto **BORDEAUX** and go to **ARBOR**
- Take a **LEFT** onto **ARBOR**
- Take a **RIGHT** on **TOURIGA** until **PALOMINO**
- Take a **LEFT** on **PALOMINO** to **BERNAL** and you are done.

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Parade Timing & Decorations

- Dress-up and come for the parade and decorate your car for Halloween!!!!
- Groups of grade levels or classes can plan to meet in their cars in nearby parking lots then caravan over and up Concord Street around your designated time.
- Families with students at different grade levels can pick when they will go in the parade - *please don't loop around and rejoin!*

Timings:

- **TK/Kindergarten** families will start the parade and should drive by the school starting at **10:00 am**
- **1st Grade** families are next - and should drive by the school around **10:15 am**
- **2nd Grade** families are next - and should drive by the school around **10:30 am**
- **3rd Grade** families are next - and should drive by the school around **10:45 am**
- **4th Grade** families are next - and should drive by the school around **11:00 am**
- **5th Grade** families will be next - and should drive by the school around **11:15 am**



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Official Rules (Alameda County & PUSD)



The Vintage Hills Parade is considered a highly regulated vehicle-based gathering:

- During the entirety of the gathering every participant remains in a fully enclosed motorized vehicle and all occupants of each enclosed vehicle are members of a single household. For clarity, an enclosed vehicle **does not** include a motorcycle, a convertible with the top open, a vehicle with no doors, or bicycle.
- **Vehicle-Based Gatherings** must adhere to the following requirements: The gathering must have a designated organizational host, **Mr. O'Brien**, who is responsible for ensuring compliance with this Order and the Shelter in Place Order during the gathering. Only those personnel, **Staff of Vintage Hills**, of the organization necessary to facilitate the gathering and to ensure compliance with this Order can be present. Participation for staff is optional.
- For gatherings of more than 10 vehicles, request security staffing provided by the local law enforcement agency with primary jurisdiction for the location of the event, the **Pleasanton Police Department**.
- Participants and Personnel must adhere to the Face Covering Order and the Social Distancing Requirements as described in the Shelter in Place Order at all times.
- The occupants of a vehicle must be members of the same household and shall not change vehicles during the gathering. Families driving by as part of a parade should not get out of their cars. Further, no more than the legal occupancy in the vehicle is allowed.
- Our gathering is limited to no more than 200 vehicles and can be no longer than 3 hours.
- If any of the windows on a vehicle are open, the occupants of the vehicle must wear a face covering in conformance with the Face Covering Order.
- Occupants cannot use their time outside of the vehicle to interact with occupants of other vehicles.
- No sales or exchanges of any items or food or drink is permitted during the gathering. Any items or food and related refuse brought by occupants of a vehicle must remain in the vehicle.
